



CLIMAT CEVENOL

IGP Cévennes - Red

The Climat Cévenol range is the expression of a winegrowing territory, that of Saint Maurice at the foot of the Cévennes. Climat Cévenol comes in three colors, the fruit of a selection of different expressions of terroir and varieties harvested in the north, south, east and west. They are the result of a remarkable climatology on account of the close proximity of the Cévennes. A part of these wine territories is carried out in organic farming.



Soil: Limestone-Clay

Varieties: Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah

Age of Vines: 20 to 40 years old



Vinification: Destemming and crushing, fermentations in thermo-regulated tanks



Ageing: Stainless steel tanks

ABV: 13% vol

Yield: 60 hl/ha

- Visual Aspect:

Deep violet with great clarity

- Nose:

Aromas of wild forest berries, touch of vanilla

- Palate:

Lively and luscious, sweet finish with well integrated tannins



Food Pairing:

Grilled meats, gratins with vegetables and herbs, chocolate and red fruits



Service Temperature: 16-18°

Conservation : 2 to 3 years
