The challenge of this single vineyard wine: to combine a Mediterranean character and the search for the finesse and freshness of the Pinot Noir grape. Bel Air is savored in the image of Vincent, its vigneron: a straight wine, taut and structured underlying great finesse... A true character.



Soil: Gravel on Limestone

Variety: Pinot Noir

Age of Vines: 20 to 40 years old



Vinification: Destemming and crushing, fermentations in thermo-regulated tanks



Ageing: 30% aged in new barrels

ABV: 13% vol Yield: 50 hl/ha

Intense ruby red with high clarity

Notes of red currant jam

- Palate:

The mouth is elegant, well balanced, with spices and black fruit



Food Pairing:

Red tuna carpaccio, pot au feu
