IGP Cévennes – Red

The Climat Cévenol range is the expression of a winegrowing territory, that of Saint Maurice at the foot of the Cévennes. Climat Cévenol comes in three colors, the fruit of a selection of different expressions of terroir and varieties harvested in the north, south, east and west. They are the result of a remarkable climatology on account of the close proximity of the Cévennes. A part of these wine territories is carried out in organic farming.



Soil: Limestone-Clay

Variety: Merlot (selection of different territories)

Age of Vines: 20 to 40 years old



Vinification: Destemming.

Fermentations in thermo-regulated tanks



Ageing: 50% stainless steel, 50% barrels

ABV: 13,5% vol

Yield: 60 hl/ha

- Visual Aspect:

Intense color with tints of eggplant

- Nose:

Aromas of red fruit, caramel, licorice

- Palate:

Fruity and luscious, balanced with fine tannins



Food Pairing:

Grilled meats, various vegetables dishes, blackberry tart



Service Temperature: 16-18°

Conservation: 2 to 3 years
