Soil: Gravel on Limestone

Varieties: Pinot Noir

Age of Vines: 20 to 40 years old



Vinification: Destemming, fermentations in thermo-regulated tanks



Ageing: 30% aged in barrels

ABV: 13% vol

Yield: 50 Hl/ha
